I just want to let everyone know that three high school students received notification of positive COVID-19 tests today. The high school administration quickly implemented our contact tracing procedures and identified 43 students who were in direct contact with the affected students. All of these students will be under quarantine at home for 14 days. Their parents have been contacted and will be monitoring their children for symptoms. Virtual lessons will be provided until they can safely return to school.

I want to assure you that we will continue to keep our schools clean and safe as we work our way through the school year. We know that we will be dealing with COVID-19 for many months to come. The risk mitigation procedures that we put into place at the beginning of the school year are working. We will continue to isolate and quarantine students as needed to protect all our students and staff members. Our goal is to keep our schools open for in-person instruction as long as it is safe to do so.

Thank you for helping us to keep our schools safe. I truly appreciate everyone's cooperation and support of our school district during these challenging times.
